Tippling ~ BMCC is a non-tipping facility excluding caddies and shoe service.

Attire ~ Appropriate golf attire is required on the golf course and practice areas. All golfers must wear shirts with collars and sleeves, except that female golfers may wear sleeveless shirts with collars or collarless shirts with sleeves. Mock turtle necks must have long sleeves. Shirt tails are to be tucked in. Denim and camouflage are not permitted.

Cell Phones ~ The use of cell phones and other verbal communication devices are not permitted on the Practice Putting Green and other areas clearly visible from the Clubhouse. The use of such devices is strongly discouraged on all other areas of the Golf Course and Practice Areas. Cell phones should be turned off or in vibrate mode when on Club property. No audible use of cell phones in Clubhouse.

Hats ~ Men shall not wear hats (or visors) in the Clubhouse, including the Golf Shop and Locker Room. Hats are not to be worn backwards.

Locker Room ~ All guests are to use the Locker Room facilities to change clothes and shoes. The Club prohibits the changing of shoes in the parking lot.
